Expression of Interest for Empanelment of Recognized Qualified Person for preparation of Mining Plan for Minor Minerals.

Guidelines for Recognized Qualified Persons (RQPs)

As per the New Bihar Minor Mineral Rules, 2017, Rule 20 requires that the Department shall prepare the panel of Recognized Qualified Person who shall prepare the Mining Plan of Mining Lease for Minor Minerals like sand, stone etc. These Recognized Qualified Persons shall prepare the Mining Plan on behalf of the Settlee and as per the directions of the Department.

2. The Recognized Qualified Person shall be a person with following eligibility: -

- a. Graduate in Engineering *Preferably* in Mining Technology or Geology; or
- b. Graduate in Engineering (Civil with specialisation in Hydrology); or
- c. Graduate in Architecture; or
- d. Post Graduate in Geology/Geography; or
- e. Any Post Graduate/Graduate/Diploma/Certificate Course in Geo Informatics or Remote Sensing or GIS or Hydrology or such other allied subjects; or
- f. Accredited Consultants of Quality Council of India may also apply; or
- g. Accredited Consultants of National Accreditation Board of Education and Training may also apply.

3. **Experience:** - The RQP should have an experience of 3 years in working in Mining/Construction/Architecture/Survey/Remote Sensing/GIS or such allied activities.

4. The Recognized Qualified Person should have an office in Patna or in any of the districts within the State of Bihar. The Recognized Qualified Person should have basic IT infrastructure in his office like computers, printers etc.

5. The Recognized Qualified Person shall charge a fixed rate for the preparation of Mining Plan. The rate shall be per hectare as fixed by the Department.

6. The Recognized Qualified Person shall submit the Mining Plan within 15 days of the work being allotted to him on behalf of the Settlee.

7. He should necessarily travel the area for which he shall be preparing the Mining Plan and shall give a certificate to this effect.

8. The Panel for Recognized Qualified Person shall be for a period of 2 years and shall be revised from time to time.

9. If it comes to the notice to the Department about certain unethical practices by the Recognized Qualified Person, then the Department shall, after giving due opportunity of being heard, may black list the said Recognized Qualified Person and/or impose suitable penalty on him.

10. The RQPs shall be paid on a per hectare basic for each Mining Plan: – However, the minimum remuneration will be Rs. 10,000/- per Mining Plan.

Bid Invitation – (a) Individual/Firms may apply enclosing all the papers and proof of experience. **They should also quote their per hectare rates inclusive all taxes and GST. They should also mention the names of the district(s) of the State in which they would be willing to work.**

(b) Individuals/Firms having relevant experience and capability to undertake the assignment are requested to submit applications in sealed envelope on or before 15.11.2017 by 5 PM at the following address:-
